


Praying through the Gospel of Mark

Station 4 - He took her hand




I was in the world like a blind man, like an atheist, ignorant of my God, but you yourself had pity on me and turned me back to yourself.

You caused your light to shine so brightly in my darkness, and called me back to you, my Maker.




- Find a place to sit quietly

- As you do you might like to listen to this piece of music by Einaudi, taken from his album Seven Days Walking // Day 4




Read this passage from Mark chapter 1. What words or phrases strike you?
