

Station 21 - they worship me in vain




Lord, help me enter into that peace which consists in having put my life in your hands.

- Find a place to sit quietly.
- Sit in a relaxed position
 - Become aware of your feet on the floor.
 - Notice your legs. Tense and relax your muscles.
 In the same way notice the rest of your body, bit by bit. Tense and relax.
 - Lastly focus on your face and head muscles.
 Tense and relax.
 - Scan your body.
 - Notice any points of remaining tension. Tense and relax.
 - Let any remaining tension go.
 - Come to a place of rest.
- Be aware of God's loving eyes watching over you.
- As we Journey with Jesus ask God for the grace to notice his presence with you in all things.

You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to human traditions."




Read these words from Mark chapter 7 again slowly. Stay with one of the words or phrases that catches you and hold it in the stillness before God.
